In the event two teams are tied on aggregate goals scored at the end of Regulation time in the 2nd Leg (Championship Round) the following tie-breaker criteria shall be applied:

1. Greater aggregate number of away goals scored in regulation time in the two matches.
2. Greater number of goals scored in the overtime periods at the end of the second match (away goal rule does not apply).
3. Kicks from the Penalty Spot procedure (as per FIFA Laws of the Game).
